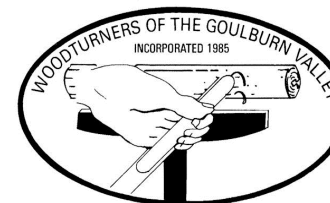

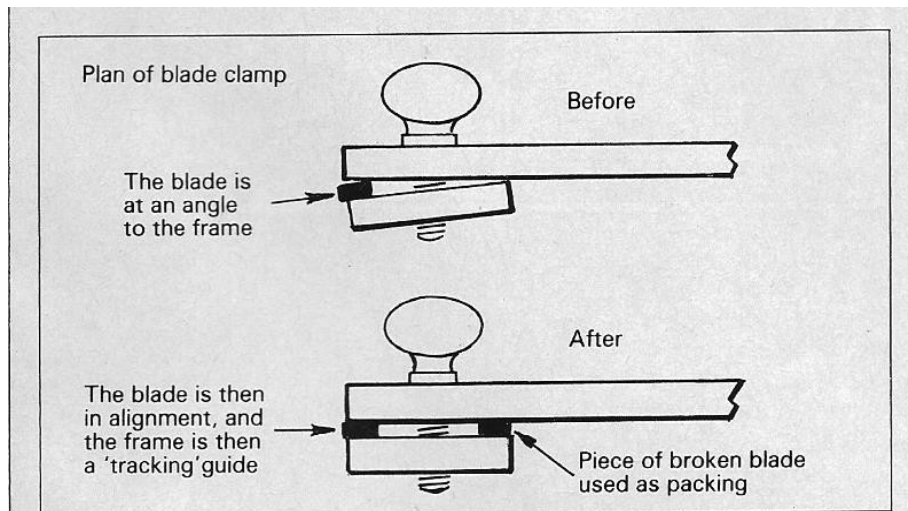
Our next meeting is our Annual General Meeting, 21st.Aug. please support your club with your attendance.

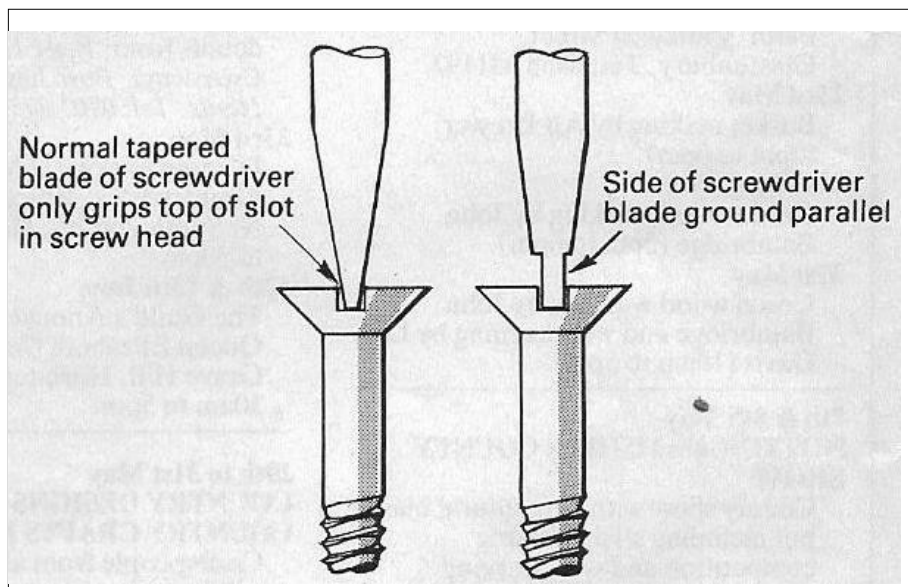

## GROOVY

A MOST useful tool for quick repetitive sizing when turning spindles, spigots, dowels and the like is a King Dick spanner.

A caliper is alright for measuring, but not strong enough to be pushed over the revolving spindle in the same way that the spanner can.

Simply adjust the spanner to the required diameter and gently press on to the spindle as it revolves in the lathe. The resulting groove is then trimmed out with a turning tool to the length desired.

The above is a good guide when using an open ended for turning small spindle work, the number on the spanner is the size in metric or imperial. They can be used while the lathe is running.

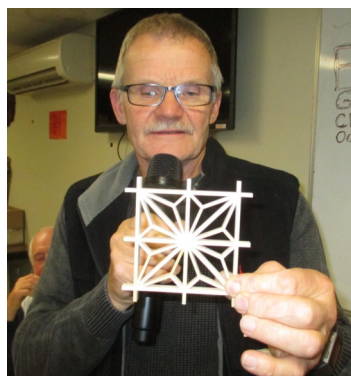
