Vern – Sales Office Staffing looks to be understaffed.

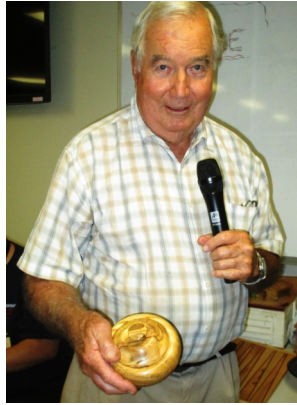
