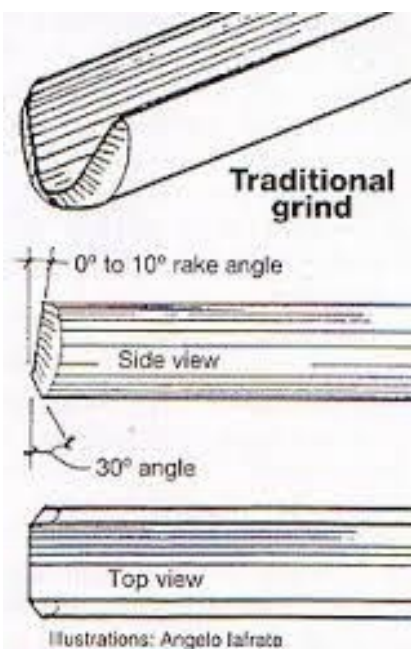

Transition grind

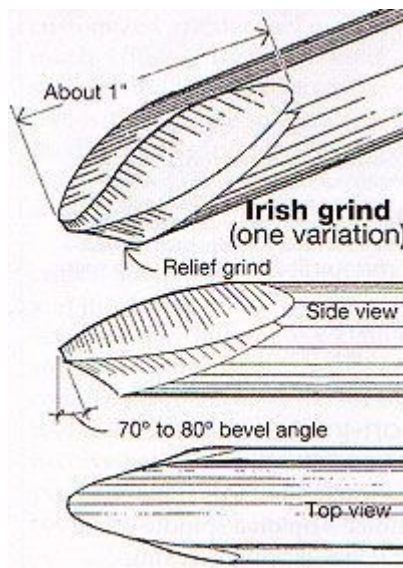

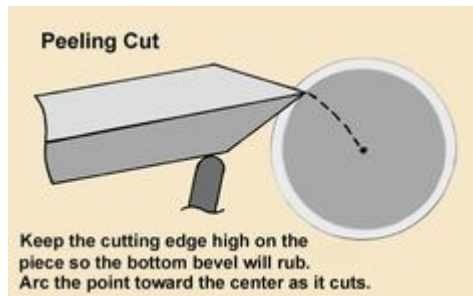
